Residents and visitors alike must share the responsibility for making our beaches turtle-friendly!

The sea turtles are very sensitive against noise, light and garbage. Noise and light disturbs their sense of direction. Non-degradable pollutants like plastic bags and bottles cause the deaths of many sea turtles who mistake them for food. Please:

- 1. NO FIREWORK ON THE BEACH EXCEPT NEW YEAR!
NO FIRES ON THE BEACH!**
- 2. NO LOUD MUSIC. MUSIC IS FORBIDDEN AFTER 10 P.M.**
- 3. SHUT OFF OR SHIELD LIGHTS AT NIGHT THAT ARE VISIBLE FROM THE BEACH!**
- 4. USE 25 WATT-BUG LIGHTS!**
- 5. REMOVE BEACH LITTER!**
- 6. LEAVE NEST SITES UNDISTURBED!**
- 7. QUIETLY OBSERVE A NESTING TURTLE OR HUTCHING TURTLES FROM A DISTANCE. DO NOT SHINE ANY LIGHTS ON HER. NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY!**
